關良

1900-1986 出生於中國廣東

- 1900 生於中國廣東省番禺縣。
- 1917 赴日留學,先後進入東京川端研究所及東京太平洋美術學校,師從藤島武二及中村不折 等。
- 1922 學成歸國後先後任教於上海美術專科學校、新華藝術專科學校及上海藝術大學、武昌藝術專科學校、廣州市立美術學校、重慶國立藝術專科學校及杭州國立藝術專科學校。
- 1925 仟立達學園美術科教授。
- 1926-27 參加北伐戰爭,任國民革命北伐軍總政治部宣傳科藝術股股長。
- 1928 7月,與雷迅設立繪畫音樂社,並開始徵收會員。 8月,與丁衍庸、陳之佛及譚華牧等共同發起成立「上海藝術俱樂部」。
- 1937-45 抗戰期間,於大後方從事藝術活動。後曾任上海中國畫院畫師、上海文史館館長及上海交通大學藝術研究室主任兼顧問。
- 1940 在重慶任國立藝術專科學校教授,其間去西北以及峨嵋山等地旅行寫生。
- 1957 文化部派關良與李可染率團赴德國訪問,同時德國萊比錫依姆茵采爾出版公司出版了《關 良戲曲人物畫冊》,併入世界美術全集叢書。
- 1958 3月,關良與賴少其、林風眠、陳煙橋、吳大羽及邵克萍等上海美術家十餘人到上海東郊同心生產合作社參加勞動。
- 1961 作《廣東造船廠》,後為中國美術館收藏。
- 1983 應激赴美,在紐約訪問、考察及講學為時近半年。
- 1986 11月28日病逝於上海。
- 1987 為紀念關良逝世一週年,11月30日由上海美術館召開「關良藝術學術研討會」。

代表性展覽

- 1922 關良與於東京所成立之藝術社成員,包括許敦谷、陳抱一及胡根天等四人由日返國參加「藝術社繪畫展」,為其等作品首次發表,展出並開畫展收費之先例。其間俞寄凡與日籍畫家小森猛亦臨時加入畫展。
- 1924 參與神州女學同仁包括許敦谷及陳抱一之三人聯展,於上海寧波旅滬同鄉會展出,展出作品達 30 餘幅。
- 1928 10 月,作品《戀歌》參加上海藝術協會第一屆展覽會,其他西畫參展者包含徐悲鴻、陳 抱一及丁衍庸等計 89 人。

- 1932 参加中華學藝社新落成紀念美術展覽會之西畫部聯展。
- 1939 6月「關良油畫展」,由上海大新公司畫廊舉辦。
- 1946 「中國現代繪畫展覽」,趙無極主辦,在重慶自然科學博物館展出林風眠、吳大羽、關良、 丁衍庸、李仲生及趙無極等中國現代畫家聯展。
- 1947 1月20日至2月1日於上海大新公司畫廊展出「關良風景水彩畫、油畫展」。
- 1957 赴德訪問,期間在柏林藝術學院舉行個展。 5月2日至12日於北京美協展覽館展出「關良教授畫展」,由中國美協主辦,展出關良作品134件。
- 1960 廣州市文化局與中國美協廣州分會在廣州畫院舉辦關良畫展。
- 1981 「關良油畫水墨畫展」,展出關良自 1929 至 1981 年所創作具代表性之油畫 38 幅、水墨 104 幅,題材包括戲劇人物、花果及山水。
